Week 1: Saturday 1 - Sunday 2 February

1st-2nd **Thailand** - The Thai wai or bow is used to greet, thank, apologise or show respect. It is an all-purpose gesture with levels of expression. For example, to greet a king the protocol necessitates bowing all the way to the ground rather than a slight bend forward. May Thai's, through our broadcasts, come to bow their hearts and give their allegiance fully to the eternal King.

Week 2: Monday 3 - Sunday 9 February

3rd **Cambodia** - Using social media platforms like Facebook Live, listeners can tune in despite weak or low signals areas. Give thanks for creative media.

4th **Vietnam** - God is at work among the Khmu people with many believers baptised last year. Pray for our programmes to strengthen faith.

5th **Indonesia** - Please uphold FEBC Indonesia. A nation of deep spiritual needs, may listeners hear God calling them personally. 1 Sam 3:10

6th **Waitangi Day** - Pray for godly leadership in New Zealand. Although the Treaty has been misinterpreted, God's heart is good and for community.

7-9th **Liangyou Theological Seminary**- "As I am taking courses at LTS and serving on overseas missions at the same time I use the course materials directly," Yam, Henan Province. Pray each student will experience the transforming work of the Spirit that they may be equipped to lead. Eph 3: 16

Week 3: Monday 10 - Sunday 16 February

10th **Nepal** - Difficult terrain makes economic development a challenge, keeping many in poverty. FEBA broadcast life enhancing programmes, please pray.

11th **Kyrgyzstan** - Praise God for the granting of another FM frequency, this time for Osh, the southern capital of Kyrgyzstan! May many come to Christ.

12th **First Response Radio** - Preparation is key. Please uphold our teams and pray for the necessary resources to be in place before the next disaster. Mtt 24:42

13th **Middle East** - "I've been listening for months, learning about Christian beliefs. I now read the Bible and feel God speaking to me." Hallelujah!

14-16th **Yemen**- Weapons are plentiful but water, food and medical supplies are scarce. The civil war is being prolonged by the rich Gulf states on either side propping up arms supplies. The suffering is unparalleled yet the Yemeni church stands. Pray for Christians to be protected and for grace to flourish.

Week 4: Monday 17 - Sunday 23 February

17th **Malawi**- The newest FEBC member, pray for the granting of the FM license so that we can start broadcasting. Pray for content development and staff.

18th **International Service Team** -Evaluating stations and their impact provides valuable feedback to improve ministry. Pray for His guidance. Mtt 25:23

19th **Moldova**- Biblical programmes on relationships open hearts. Pray for Moldova, crippled by a failing economy which places great strain on families.

20th **Russia** - "It is tormenting to be young and have no hope." Irina is an FEBC broadcaster in Buryat where Buddhism, shamanism and atheism meld.

21st-23rd **Ukraine**- Pray for our 'Wounded by the War' team. Military commanders report their gratitude for our ministry. Many soldiers suffer from alcoholism, hopelessness, and there continues to be suicides. God is changing lives. Pray for His grace and mercy to heal the suffering. Pray for an end to the war.

Week 5: Monday 24 - Saturday 29 February

24th **Bible Correspondence**- Pray for the Spirit's work in those that receive our correspondences, many of which are in prison. May they believe. Jn 16: 13

25th **Japan** - "Now I understand, faith is not about understanding doctrine but meeting Jesus in prayer." 67yrs broadcasting in Japan, pray for the harvest.

26th **Thailand** - Listening to FEBC programmes aired on a host AM station corrected an isolated village church's false theology. Wonderful Counselor!

27th **Cambodia** - "Family FM is my pastor because through your broadcasts I learn to care for my family and strengthened my faith." Suos. Give thanks.

28-29th **Vietnam** - There are 70 million deaf in the world, most are unreached by the Gospel. Through animation, drama and other audio visual programming our team are reaching into the deaf community of Vietnam, including hosting a weekly fellowship, please pray for this ministry.
