Week 1: Friday 1 - Sunday 3 May

1st - 3rd **First Response Radio** - Displaced communities feel very vulnerable in the aftermath of disasters. Broadcasting important and practical information on keeping safe as well as where to go to report security issues enables communities to rebuild and allows for trauma recovery. Psychosocial healing is also a vital component of recovery. Please uphold this ministry.

Week 2: Monday 4 - Sunday 10 May

4th **Moldova** - "Since listening, my small salary or my family problems haven't changed but I have hope now, God is changing me!" Anna. Give thanks
5th **Russia** - Please pray for our follow up counsellors. May God give them wisdom to bring inquirers closer to God.
6th **Ukraine** - "Real Ukrainian men don't go to church, so I agreed to listen to FEBC," laughs Dima. He and Natasha now share adoption advice on-air.
7th **Discipleship** - Christian discipleship transforms an encounter with Christ into a daily walk with Christ. Pray for FEBC's role in maturing believers.
8-10th **Yemen** - Children in Yemen face all the same dangers of adults, with no idea where to turn. Yemeni believers requested children's Bible stories and resources, so we broadcast these regularly. Pray these build resilience and hope. Mt 19:14

Week 3: Monday 11 - Sunday 17 May

11th **China** - 2020's broadcasting theme is "Voice Resounding" - Bible study and application. Pray for strong discipleship. Ps 119:133 "Direct my steps..."
12th **Kyrgyzstan** - "Your broadcasts challenged me to look at myself. With God I hope to become better," Sapargul. May listeners heed God's leading.
13th **First Response Radio** - FRR's suitcase studio received international praise in London at a Disaster Response Expo. Give thanks for this ministry that allows prompt disaster response.
14th **Thailand** - "It is a blessing to listen to FEBC. Living a faithful Christian life can be difficult, please pray for us." Intercede for our Thai brothers & sisters.
15-17th **Indonesia** - Pray for the MORE project, where our programmes are aired on 100+ privately owned radio stations. Many listeners in rural areas may now be able to hear of Christ's salvation in this Muslim country. Pray too for Spirit inspired content. Only he knows what listeners need to hear.

Week 4: Monday 18 - Sunday 24 May

18th **Literacy** - 790 million FEBC listeners are illiterate. Employing indigenous staff enables FEBC to convey the Good News in the heart language of listeners. May God strengthen our ministry until all have heard!
19th **Programme Content** - Please pray for insightful creativity as each production team expresses Kingdom values to address current social issues.
20th **Ethnic Minorities** - Formerly considered unreached the Dongxiang people have a small number of believers. Wanting to reach out, they are seeking resources to create an audio Bible in their language. Please pray.
21st **Cambodia** - "I couldn't control my temper. My wife encouraged me to tune in. Thank you for introducing me to God." - Mr Ponlok. Pray for Voice of Love as they share the Good News!
22-24th **Vietnam** - Please intercede for our team as they continue to look for new ways to reach marginalised and unreached people. Pray too for receptive hearts who will not dismiss it as "Western" religion. May there be funding so that listeners may have the opportunity to hear over time of His love.

Week 5: Monday 25 - Sunday 31 May

25th **Yemen** - One of FEBC's objectives is to strengthen isolated Yemeni believers. Our programmes are a lifeline to them. Ps 91:4
26th **Eurasia** - Please pray for FEBC's ministries in these countries. Pray for godly leaders to bring Christ to these mostly Muslim peoples.
27th **Ukraine** - "It is an honour to share the Good News amidst pain and see new life despite the war and poverty," Viktor Kurylenko, senior broadcaster.
28th **Gabbies** - Please pray for Owen as he seeks direction for his retirement this year. Owen and Irene will continue to work for FEBC part time voluntarily.
29-31st **First Response Radio** - Local trained teams situated in four major hubs throughout South-East Asia trained in disaster recovery in the local language, deployed to local disasters is the key to quick response and community engagement.
